

Urology FY1 Weekend Shifts

1. Meet urology reg in **W33 'Urology Registrar Office' room**
2. Prepare the **patient list prior to ward round**
3. Complete ward round jobs including chasing bloods
4. **Update the patient list** at the end of the day with any new blood/scan results and any updated plans
5. **Put out bloods** (CRRS > Requests/Referrals > Pathology Request > Phlebotomist required) for the Monday for patients who require them

How to access the list:

1. Computer > GSEF drive > Urology > Patient lists > 2023 > Select month/date
2. Copy and paste yesterday's list to create today's list, and save it with today's date

Updating the list:

1. Patients highlighted in grey on the patient list may have been discharged – you can check on the top right hand corner of VitalPac to see if they are admitted/discharged. **If they have been discharged, delete them from the list**

2. Use VitalPac to **update NEWS and location** of patients on the list
3. Use CRRS to find **newly admitted patients** to add to the list:
 - CRRS > Handover > select SAU from drop down menu > find new patients who are under 'Urology'
 - Add patient name, hospital number and location to the list. If there are bloods/scan results, you can add them too e.g.

4. Use CRRS to find patients **who underwent surgery yesterday** who will need review/discharge today:
 - CRRS > Home > Theatre Lists dropdown menu
 - Select yesterday on this dropdown menu, then select the urology lists to find patients who are admitted post-operatively, add them to the list

Please save and close the patient list when you are finished so others can access it.
